We require 3 types of donations

1. We always need the following items to give to clients daily:
 -  New men's socks and underwear
 -  Men's shoes, trainers and boots
 -  Men's and women's jeans, trousers, shirts, jumpers and coats

- Unused toiletries such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, shower gel, shampoo & deodorant
 - We also need homeware items to give to recently housed clients including: dish/china sets, pots & pans, cutlery, curtains, new kettles & toasters etc. We cannot accept used bedding.
2. Men/women's work clothes for interviews and employment:
- Suits, shirts, overcoats/raincoats, ties, belts etc.
3. High end designer or vintage items that we can sell in our annual Pop Up shop #OneGoodThing:
- Men & women's designer clothing, shoes & accessories like bags, jewellery, scarves etc.
 - Vintage and retro homeware, small furniture, pictures, paintings, china, glass and bric-a-brac
